Dear Softball Enthusiast,

The City of San Luis Obispo Parks and Recreation Department is preparing for the 2010 Fall Softball Season. Parks and Recreation leagues provide a sociable atmosphere for both men's and coed teams of all skill levels. Spaces are available for new teams.

Registration for RETURNING TEAMS begins Monday, August 2, 2010 and runs through Friday, August 6, 2010. NEW TEAMS (and returning) can register Monday, August 9 – August 13, 2010. No late registration forms will be accepted. Each team is scheduled for 10 games per season. The registration fee for all new teams is \$572 per team for the fall season, which includes the team's insurance coverage for the year. Returning teams (from spring or summer 2010) pay \$465 per team. New teams must turn in a full roster upon registration OR must turn one in to the scorekeeper at the field before the first game.

Registration fees are due in full in order to register. Please do not have players come down individually to pay for their share of the fee. Please have one large payment or a collection of payments all together and ready when you register. Shirts are not provided for each team, but are rewarded to players on the championship team of each league.

Any player who is not on the roster will have to fill out an add form. After the first game a team may add players to their roster (\$5 fee per player) until the fifth game of the season. Payment for the add fee cannot be collected at the fields and must be paid at the Parks and Recreation Administrative Offices.

The season starts Monday, August 30, 2010.

Leagues are determined by skill level, not by which night the team prefers to play. Although it's the goal to accommodate each team with their preferred night, in order to keep the leagues fair, leagues will only be created that serve similar skill levels (i.e. lower and upper teams will not play each other).

All registration takes place at the Parks and Recreation Administrative Offices, 1341 Nipomo Street; Monday-Thursday, 9 a.m.-5:30 p.m. and Friday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m. If you have any questions, feel free to contact me using the number/email below. Thank you and we look forward to seeing you this fall!

The league classification is determined by ability level. The City of San Luis Obispo Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to alter league sizes, costs, change team classification during season, or even cancel leagues as deemed necessary.

Lower: The least competitive league. No more than three upper level players per team

Middle: No more than five upper level players per team

Upper: For teams with skill, experience and the desire to be the best in the SLO area

Wednesday: Men's Lower, Men's Middle, Coed Lower

I further understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during softball games; and that participants in said sport occasionally sustain serious personal injuries, and/or property damage, as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risk of softball, nevertheless, I hereby agree to those risks and to release and hold harmless all persons or entities mentioned above who (through negligence or carelessness) might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs or assigns) for damages.

It is further understood that this waiver, release, and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns.
