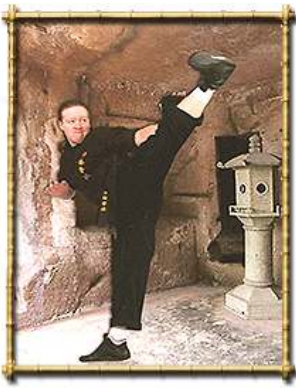
Performance Athletics ~ Gymnastics, Cheerleading & Dance

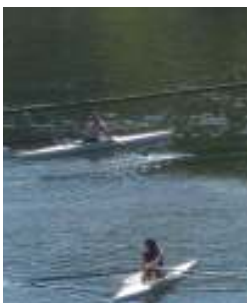
Gary Schmidt ~ Shaolin Kempo Martial Arts
