WHAT: INJURY COLLISION, MOTORCYCLIST INTO A BUILDING

WHERE: 200 Block of Tank Farm Road

WHEN: January 17, 2012 at 0712 hours

DRIVER: Wyatt Chan, age 20, San Luis Obispo

At about 0712 hours a citizen located a motorcyclist down in the 200 block of Tank Farm Road and called 911. The officers determined that Wyatt Chan was riding a motorcycle westbound in the 200 block of Tank Farm Road when he left the roadway for an unknown reason. Chan collided with a building after leaving the roadway. Chan was thrown from the motorcycle and sustained major injuries. The collision severed a water line inside the building. We have not been able to find anyone who witnessed the collision nor do we have an exact time of occurrence. As far as we know, there were no other vehicles involved in this accident. The officers were unable to locate a motorcycle helmet at the scene of the accident so we are not sure if Chan was wearing one or not.

Chan was transported to Sierra Vista Hospital and is listed in critical condition.
