3. COMMITTEE BYLAWS (FUKUSHIMA – 10 MINUTES)

Each city advisory body has approved bylaws that set forth procedures, purpose, meetings, officers, etc. (City Charter, Article XII, Section 1204). Every two years, the bylaws of each

advisory body shall be reviewed, and any recommended changes will be submitted to the City Council for approval (see Attachment 3). If a proposed change is substantial, it may require bringing back to the committee at a later meeting for more in depth discussion and review. 5. ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN BICYCLE POLICIES
(FUKUSHIMA – 80 MINUTES)

This item will identify bicycle policies for the Active Transportation Plan. Committee members should consider broad, city-wide policies to promote bicycle transportation.

What is a policy?

As listed in the current Bicycle Transportation Plan, a policy is generally a principle “that guides implementation of the Plan and other actions associated with bicycling.” Policies can range from design to maintenance, education, funding, and evaluation. Committee members should review the policies in the current Bicycle Transportation Plan beginning on page 30 and continuing throughout the Plan as well as policies relating to bicycling in the Circulation Element to the General Plan (see Attachment 4)

This agenda item will complement the ATC meeting on 9/19/19 when the committee identified pedestrian policies.
