## **SLO Transit Public Meeting**

- Wednesday, August 17<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 PM and 6:00 PM -

**San Luis Obispo, CA** – The City of San Luis Obispo Transit (SLO Transit), as a recipient of federal transit funds and in compliance with federal regulations, will conduct a public meeting on Wednesday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 4:30 PM and 6:00 PM. The meeting is to be held at the City/County Library Community Room located at 995 Palm Street in San Luis Obispo. Attendees will have an opportunity to review and comment on the following required documents: the Major Service Reduction & Fare Increase Public Notification Policy, the Title VI Plan, and the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program Plan.

The Major Service Reduction & Fare Increase Public Notification Policy outlines the SLO Transit public notification and meeting procedure with respect to major service reduction and fare increase as should they ever become necessary. The Title VI Plan outlines the commitment of SLO Transit in ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of its transit services on the basis of race, color, or national origin. The DBE Program Plan establishes the methodology and a 1.7% DBE goal for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) assisted contracts in federal fiscal years 2015 through 2017.
