SLO Transit Offers FREE Bus Service

- Free Bus Service During Rideshare Week, October 3 – 7, 2016 -

San Luis Obispo, CA – In celebration of Rideshare Week, the City of San Luis Obispo Transit (SLO Transit) will provide the public with free rides systemwide Monday – Friday, October 3 – 7, 2016. Free rides on SLO Transit make it easy for the public to make a smart commute by riding the bus. Smart commute choices also include biking, walking, carpooling, and vanpooling.

Rideshare Week is celebrated by SLO County every October. The goal of Rideshare Week is to develop an awareness of how we commute and the impact that our commute choices have on our health and our communities. SLO Regional Rideshare, a division of SLO Council of Governments (SLOCOG), invites the public to pledge to make a smart commute on www.rideshare.org.

SLO Transit is the local fixed-route transit operation for the City of San Luis Obispo, operating directly out of the City's Public Works Department. SLO Transit operates 10 vehicles at peak along eight fixed-routes within the 23 square miles of the city limits of San Luis Obispo and California Polytechnic State University.
