Veterans Ride SLO Transit Free on Veterans Day

- SLO Transit Observes Veterans Day by Giving Free Rides to Veterans -

San Luis Obispo, CA – In honor and recognition of the men and women who have served in our nation’s armed forces, the City of San Luis Obispo Transit (SLO Transit) is offering free bus rides to U.S. military veterans on Veterans Day, Friday, November 11, 2016.

Veterans may simply show their valid veterans ID, military ID, or DD214 form when boarding any SLO Transit bus. “We appreciate the many veterans within our community and want to show them our thanks by providing them free rides,” said Dee Lawson, City of San Luis Obispo Transit Coordinator.

SLO Transit is the local fixed-route transit operation for the City of San Luis Obispo, operating directly out of the City’s Public Works Department. SLO Transit operates ten vehicles at peak along eight fixed routes within the 23 square miles of the city limits of San Luis Obispo and California Polytechnic State University. SLO Transit operates Monday through Friday approximately from 6 am to 10 pm and Saturday & Sunday from 8 am to 6 pm. You can learn more by visiting slotransit.org.
