And if you pass the above, you are accepted!

After completion of the application you will be contacted by an Explorer Advisor of your acceptance into the Explorer Post. To be accepted into the Explorer post you must have a clean criminal record and have at least a 2.0 grade point average in school. We also require that you are at least fourteen years of age. Once accepted we require eighteen hours of service a month.

What do Explorers Do?

Explorer activities range from local events, national competitions and Regional conferences .
