

Additional Disqualifying Criminal Offense and Factors

Felony Disqualifiers

- 273a(a) PC – Felony Child Endangerment;
- 266d PC – Receiving money for placing person for purposes of cohabitation;
- 266e PC – Purchasing a person for prostitution or immoral purposes;
- 266f PC – Sale of a person for immoral purposes;
- 266g PC – Placing or permitting placement of wife in house of prostitution;
- 288.2 PC – Sending Harmful matter to a minor;
- 288.3 PC – Contact with a minor with the intent to commit a sexual offense;
- 11350.5 H&S – Possession of GHB with intent to commit sexual assault;
- 11351 H&S – Possession or purchase of a controlled substance for sale (not marijuana);
- 11351.5 H&S – Possession of cocaine base for sale;
- 11352 H&S – Transportation or furnishing of a controlled substance;
- 11378 H&S – Possession of dangerous drugs for sale;
- 11378.5 H&S - Possession for sale of designated substances including phencyclidine;
- 11379 H&S – Transportation or furnishing of a dangerous drug;
- 11379.5 H&S - Transportation for sale of designated substances including phencyclidine;
- 11379.6 H&S – Manufacturing of controlled substances;
- 11375.5 H&S – Possession of a synthetic stimulant for sale;
- 11357.5 H&S – Possession of a synthetic cannabinoid for sale (spice);
- 11370.1 H&S – Possession of controlled substance while armed with a firearm;
- 11366 H&S – Maintaining a place where controlled substances are used;
- 11375 H&S – Possession of pharmaceuticals for sale;
- 11377.5 H&S – Possession of GHB, Ketamine or Rohypnol with intent to commit sexual assault;
- 11382 H&S – Sale or furnishing substances falsely represented as controlled substances;
- 11390 H&S – Cultivation of spores capable of producing mushrooms (controlled substance);
- 11391 H&S – Transporting or furnishing spores capable of producing mushrooms (controlled substance);
- 11550(e)(1) H&S – Under the influence of a controlled substance while in possession of a loaded firearm;
- 11366.8(a) H&S – False compartment to transport narcotics.

Misdemeanor Disqualifiers

- 646.9 PC – Stalking;
- 647(b)(1) – Prostitution;
- 272 PC – Contributing to the delinquency of a minor;

- 417(a)(2) PC – Brandishing a firearm.

Additional Disqualifiers

- Any person required to register in the State of California as a Sex Offender pursuant to 290 PC (Pursuant to 11358 and 11360 of the California Health and Safety Code it is a felony for a sex registrant to sell or cultivate cannabis).
- Any conviction of any subsection of 311 PC (Possession, distribution, manufacturing of child pornography).
